- Camp staff - including Host/Hostess, Chief Leader, Musician and Health-Care Personnel.
- Day leaders for hikes.
- Evening campfire program and snack.
- Emergency satellite telephone.
- **No personal tents or bikes allowed.**

Cancellation policy:

All cancellations must be in writing to the Registrar by mail or Email. In the event of such written cancellation, for any reason, all monies paid will be refunded subject to a cancellation fee per person as follows:

1. Cancellations received by 1 May: \$100.00 fee.
2. Cancellations received after May 1st but before the Monday, 6 weeks preceding the camp: \$200.00 fee
3. Cancellations received within the 6 week period before the Monday of the camp: no monies refunded, unless a replacement is found, in which case the \$200.00 fee will apply.

IF NOT, EVEN THE EASIER HIKES IN THE MOUNTAINS CAN BE STRESSFUL THERE WILL BE OPPORTUNITIES FOR A VARIETY OF HIKES, SOME MORE DIFFICULT THAN OTHERS IN TERMS OF DISTANCE AND ELEVATION GAIN, BUT BE PREPARED TO CLIMB AT LEAST 200 METERS EACH DAY. MOST PEOPLE CAN ACHIEVE THE NECESSARY LEVEL OF FITNESS, BUT IT REQUIRES LONG-RANGE EFFORT TO DEVELOP THE NECESSARY STRENGTH AND ENDURANCE.

DISCLAIMER: Skyline reserves the right to cancel or relocate a camp, either before or after its commencement, in response to unforeseen circumstances, which could include but would not be limited to closures enforced by Parks Canada. 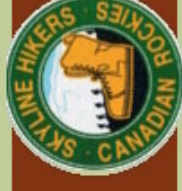
